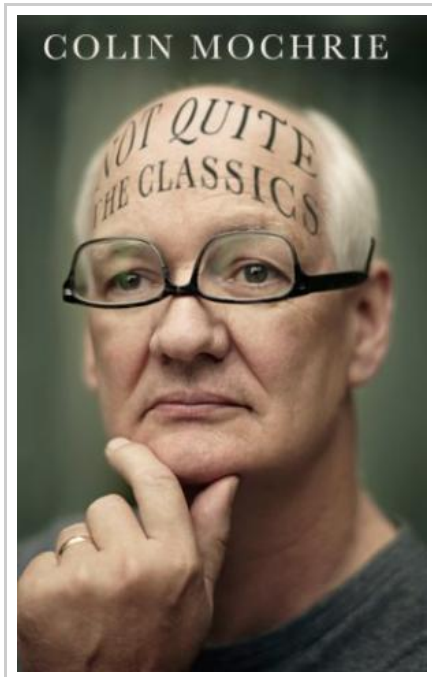




Not Quite the Classics (Paperback)
