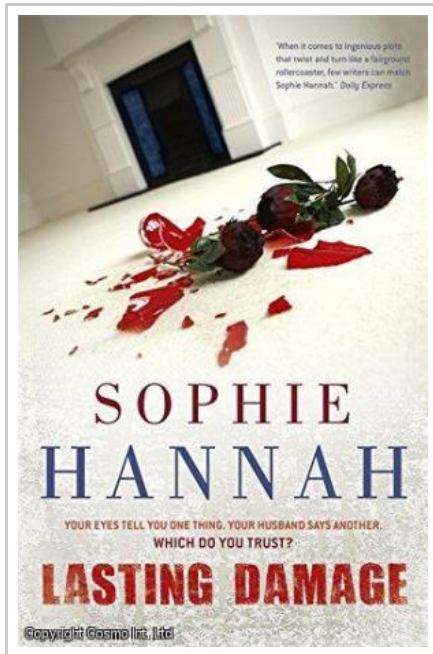




Lasting Damage (Culver Valley Crime)
